<u>After School Clubs</u>: Right now we have some clubs getting ready to start and others will begin later in the year.

Robotics: Starts October 7 for the 1st - 3rd grades TREPS: 5th – 8th and will be the second half of the year Yoga is on hold for right now, more to come on that

Dances: The first dance of the year will be the Halloween Dance. This coincides with the Trunk or Treat so that all children have something to do that night. It will be 10/25 at the Wanaque School. This is for grades 6-8.

<u>Clothing Drive</u>: Yvette: Great success outdid our poundage from last year and got a few middle schoolers some community service hours while we were at it.

<u>Gertrude Hawke</u>: will be in October with delivery for 12/2 so there will be holiday items included.

<u>Wanaque Sports Chairs</u> with the school logo and town colors are also available to show your spirit - \$30

Holiday Bazaar: Amanda is chairing. 12/7 from 10-3. Another great opportunity for community service hours. We already have 40 vendors lined almost to capacity. We will need help with crafts, loading and unloading vendors, food table, book fair etc. Lots of great new vendors, it will be a great day. Get some holiday shopping done and support our vendors. The Holiday Shop will also be open for the kids to buy gifts for their family members. We will also be selling pizza and will need volunteers there too.
