- Fun Run - For the first time this year, in early April. It is a fundraiser but we're looking at it to be just a fun day for the kids. Our field is large enough to have 2 tracks at once so two grades will go at once. It should be a fun day with balloon arches and bubble machines. Wednesday, April 5th
- Health \& Safety - Anti bullying, Rachel's Challenge. 2 different assemblies. For the younger grades, talking about kindness and not so much about the event at Columbine. They won't talk about the school shooting. Older grades they'll talk a little bit more about that. It's a little intense. A couple years ago there were some students that it really hit them and a teacher was handing out tissues. They talk about the Columbine H.S. Shooting. Rachel was the first student that lost her life at that event. It's more about what she did in her life, leaving notes on lockers, spreading kindness. Her parents found her writing about being kind and that's how Rachel's Challenge started. The younger grades won't hear any of the tragic
part of it. It's a great presentation and it went over really well a couple years ago when we had it.
- Mr. Alloy - Kindness Week starts Friday. There's a week worth of it. Tess has it planned for each day and she sent me the flier today.
- School Pictures - Sibling Pictures - March 22. Sibling and spring pictures. We'll send a separate form to organize for that.
